#### Congress 2014

Brock University is pleased to host the 2014 Congress of the Humanities and Social Sciences, and we look forward to welcoming you to Niagara in May. Our campus is located in the beautiful Niagara region, overlooking the picturesque Niagara escarpment. Attendees of Congress 2014 will enjoy being minutes away from many of Canada's renowned wineries and the exciting attractions and cultural experiences Niagara has to offer.

## Stay on Campus

To accommodate the high volume of Congress attendees at Brock University, a block of residence rooms have been reserved in five complexes on Brock's campus. We have the ability to accommodate over 1,300 Congress attendees each night, in the heart of all Congress activities. Don't miss a beat as you stay only steps away from President's Receptions, Career Corner, Big Thinking, your association's conference, special events, and the hub of it all – the Congress Centre (Registration and Expo)!

All residence rooms are equipped with internet access and are fully air conditioned. For the duration of your stay, you will receive a complimentary all-you-care-to-eat hot, buffet breakfast and complimentary parking. Parking passes will be provided upon check in.

Our Conference Services Front Desk will be open 24 hours for the convenience and service of on-campus Congress delegates. Check in time is 15:00, while check out time is 11:00.

#### **Accommodation Styles and Pricing**

Brock University is offering both single and double rooms during Congress 2014. You may select a single room with either a semi-private washroom or shared washroom. Double rooms are two single beds in one room, with the option of either a semi-private washroom or a shared washroom. For those selecting the shared washroom option, there may be up to 11 other people sharing the washroom (more traditional style of residence). For those selecting the semi-private washroom option, most delegates will have only one other person sharing the facilities. However, please note that in rare cases, there may be two other people sharing the washroom. Prices and room options are as follow:

Single room, semi-private washroom	\$69.95 per person, per night
Single room, shared washroom	\$59.95 per person, per night
Double room, semi-private washroom	\$64.95 per person, per night (\$129.90)
Double room, shared washroom	\$59.95 per person, per night (\$119.90)

Please note, prices are subject to 13% HST.









#### Accessibility

Attendees registering to stay at Brock who require accessible accommodation should state their accommodation needs during the online reservation process. Brock University has a limited number of accessible rooms for persons using mobility devices (wheelchairs, scooters, etc), along with other accessible amenities.

#### **Other Amenities**

Attendees staying on campus may also wish to take advantage of our athletic and fitness centre, located in the Walker Complex. Brock boasts a 50m indoor swimming pool with dry saunas and an on-deck whirlpool, an indoor, 200 m suspended track, the Zone fitness centre, squash courts, outdoor tennis courts, and recreational gyms. Passes for the fitness facilities start at \$5 per day and are available for purchase in the Walker Complex; please present your Congress badge upon purchase. The Congress Centre will also be conveniently housed in the Walker Complex.

While staying at Brock, be sure to visit Alphie's Trough – a unique chalet atop the Niagara escarpment, specializing in local cuisine and locally brewed beer. Be sure to experience amazing food and wonderful company at this scenic location.

### **Cancellation Policy**

Since the conference incurs certain expenses prior to your arrival and in order to plan accordingly, it is necessary for Brock University to impose the following cancellation policy:

All cancellations must be received via e-mail as per the following schedule:

- Cancellations received on or prior to Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014: Full refund minus a \$35 administration fee
- Cancellations received on or after Monday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014: No refunds may be issued

You will receive confirmation of your cancellation by e-mail. Refunds will be provided by cheque. There will be no refunds granted for attendees who do not meet the conditions outlined above.

Substitutions from the same organization may be made 48 hours prior to your arrival at no charge.

Attendees/guests who do not attend breakfast or require parking, etc, which is already included in the room fees, will not receive a refund equivalent to the cost of the amenity.
